

Member Case Study: **Regional Waste Recycling**

Challenges:

All senior management within the company is responsible for sustainability and implementing its policies throughout the organisation. The main target for the business is to reach 100% recycling in all the waste streams which they manage.

The main sustainability challenges for the business include:

- Training, qualifying and maintaining professional quality drivers.
- 2. Exploring new technology to increase recycling rates of various waste streams. Examples include efforts to enhance the sand grade quality sufficient for the production of construction materials. Heavily investing in various technologies to improve sustainability of different types of waste and refuge for reuse and recycle.
- Recycling low grade contaminated plastics. Instead of waste to energy for incineration, at this moment, reviewing and potentially implementing a viable solution that could actually produce diesel fuel from these waste plastics.

Impact:

- Collaborative approach: Regional Waste Recycling completed their selfassessments and re-assessments with multiple colleagues from across the business, bringing everyone together to discuss the questions and topics raised.
- Industry insight: Regional Waste Recycling have attended many of the School's CPD accredited workshops and have gained a useful insight into the qualifying and procurement processes for their customers.
