Challenges:



As a labour supplier and recruitment agency, Dynamic Group's people are their most precious asset. Fairness, Inclusion and Respect is of utmost importance to the

organisation and they are constantly working on embedding internal cultural values throughout all levels of the business.

Attracting new people to the industry is also important, and Dynamic Group are currently working with EYC Global to deliver over 100 free training courses in London to help with career access. Impact:

Over the past year Dynamic Group have attended 10 supplier days, various workshops and have accessed a wide range of the School's

resources on social value, modern slavery and sustainable procurement. They have also been involved in the FIR programme and have FIR Ambassadors within their team. This has had the following impacts:



- Improved understanding: The School's resources have assisted Dynamic Group with internal training which help align their internal policies and offering to their customer base. By completing company assessments and re-assessments, as well as individual assessments, Dynamic Group were positively surprised to see their score was above average in their trade category, reaffirming they are moving in the right direction.
- Implementing change: As a result of attending School workshops Dynamic Group have been able to grasp key challenges and drivers within the industry and create internal goals and strategies to ensure the business adapts to the current and future industry needs.
