

Member Case Study: Skrap Ltd

Challenges:

The biggest sustainability challenge faced by Skrap as a technology-based business is to ensure their operations and supply chain are consistently aligned with their sustainability policy.

Sustainability is reviewed every quarter by the Commercial Operational Manager, and they have set a target is to be net zero carbon by 2021 – so they have a challenge to achieve this.

Impact:

Skrap have engaged in the School through using the assessment tool, bespoke action plan and online resources, which has had the following impacts on their business:

- Gap analysis: The assessment tool challenged Skrap's knowledge on certain subjects, and clearly identified areas where improvement was required, which Skrap have then used to target specific areas to focus development, including researching into some new areas.
- Knowledge development: After identifying gaps in their knowledge, Skrap have used the School's resources and elearning modules to improve their understanding and subsequently their business processes.
- Continued learning and development: Skrap now plan to roll out relevant e-learning modules available through the School to all colleagues in the organisation to 'plug the gap' and enable knowledge development to increase across the business.

Value gained:

Skrap have gained value from being a School member:

- Internal value: It has enabled teams to adopt a focused learning approach to specific subjects which broadens the knowledge and enables employees to best serve their clients.
- Enhanced reputation: Membership shows commitment to ongoing learning and improving sustainability in the built environment which is an added value for clients and suppliers.
