Challenges:

TCi are working hard to demonstrate the long-term benefits of sustainability to people throughout the industry. A challenge is that there are so many aspects to sustainability, they need to prioritise what to do first to ensure it can be done well.



Reducing carbon impacts is a key priority, and the business is beginning to track their carbon emissions. They have got the data together, but it is sometimes a challenge to measure across their large range of sites.

Impact:

Since becoming members of the Supply Chain Sustainability School in 2017, TCi have committed to gaining a deeper understanding of sustainability and incorporate it into all aspects of their business.

- Gap analysis: The School's assessment helped TCI identify gaps in knowledge within the company and has encouraged them to look into new areas such as BIM, which had previously not been considered.
- **Knowledge development:** TCi assign the relevant resources generated through their bespoke action plan to the appropriate employees. The School's video content, which is easy to fit around a busy schedule, and digestible for people who are starting their learning journey, has been rolled out to colleagues to ensure the knowledge is embedded throughout TCi.
- Sustainable innovation: With the support of the School's resources TCi have looked at how they can innovate their products to create sustainable solutions. They have launched ECOdesk360 - a 100% sustainable workstation solution, made from 100% recyclable cardboard.
