5	<p>Plastic Packaging Tax – update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Exemptions now clear – gov.uk and HMRC websites Evidence keeping – contracts, production specifications, certificates of recycled plastic content, external accreditations – this will need documentation from suppliers. Michelmersh have been asking for proof that what suppliers are supplying is recycled etc. some of them haven't figured this out yet. Cost implications of the plastic packing tax? Nobody has put this together in detail yet but HMRC are expecting high revenues.
