

Case Study: Mabey Hire Ltd.

Challenges:



As a specialist sub-contractor and supplier of non-mechanical plant, one of the major challenges that Mabey Hire faced was pulling together everything that they already do around sustainability, tying it to a

common purpose and re-educating people about what sustainability can include (e.g. it's not just recycling, it is also about having an impact in the community etc.) They needed to ensure the fundamentals of sustainability were understood and relate to everyone within the company.

Impact:

- Internal collaboration an internal group from different departments was set up to work together to complete the initial assessments within their profile to ensure balanced and accurate responses.
