Welcome and Introductions

Athensys

Athensys is a SME based in Wales that have developed a software which takes complex documents such as contracts and policies and simplifies them for organisations/individuals in order to be able to quickly find the information they require.

General School Update:

David Emery, Sector Lead for Wales, provided the group with an update on the engagement, activity and learning within the School. The School now has 182 Partners. From July 2022 the School had 9,227 active individuals and 2,918 active companies. There were also 27,325 resource views within the School with 15,600 of these views being e-learning modules.

The table above shows the current performance of the markets within the School. The Wales market currently has 384 active companies and 909 active individuals however the target for Wales is 600 active organisation and 2,400 active individuals.

Learning Pathways:

At the last leadership group meeting it was discussed that a Wales specific learning pathway should be created within the School. The group was shown a list of the Wales specific resources we have available within the School and was asked to share their thoughts on the resources in terms of what resources should be included in the pathway and if there are any topics that are not listed that should be included.

It was discussed that a resource which explains the difference of floods requirements within Wales and England should be included. The group agreed that a learning pathway should be created to focus on the difference in legislation between Wales and England. It was mentioned that otherwise there could be duplication with resources on learning pathways as some of the Partners on the leadership group work in both England and Wales.

David Emery informed the group of the 'Downloading a Digital Mindset' project. The project has currently developed the following:
